HOW THE INTERNET WORKS

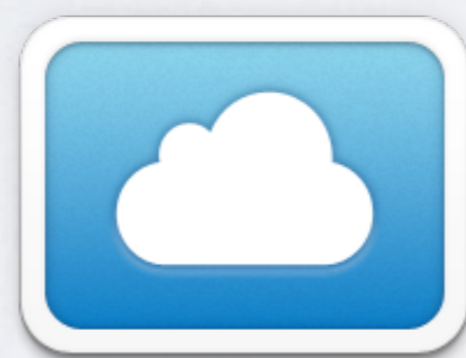
The **Internet** was conceived in the U.S. in the late 1960's, and funded by the Department of Defense.

THE WORLD WIDE WEB

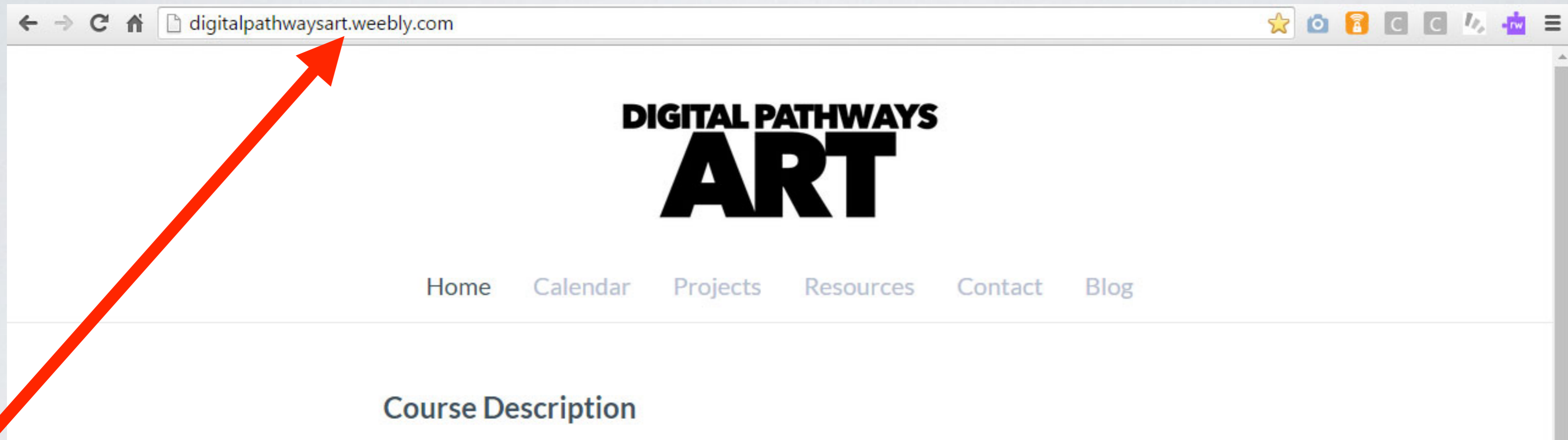
The web was developed in 1990 by Tim Berners-Lee.

The **web** is a system of Internet servers containing hypertext markup language (html) documents.

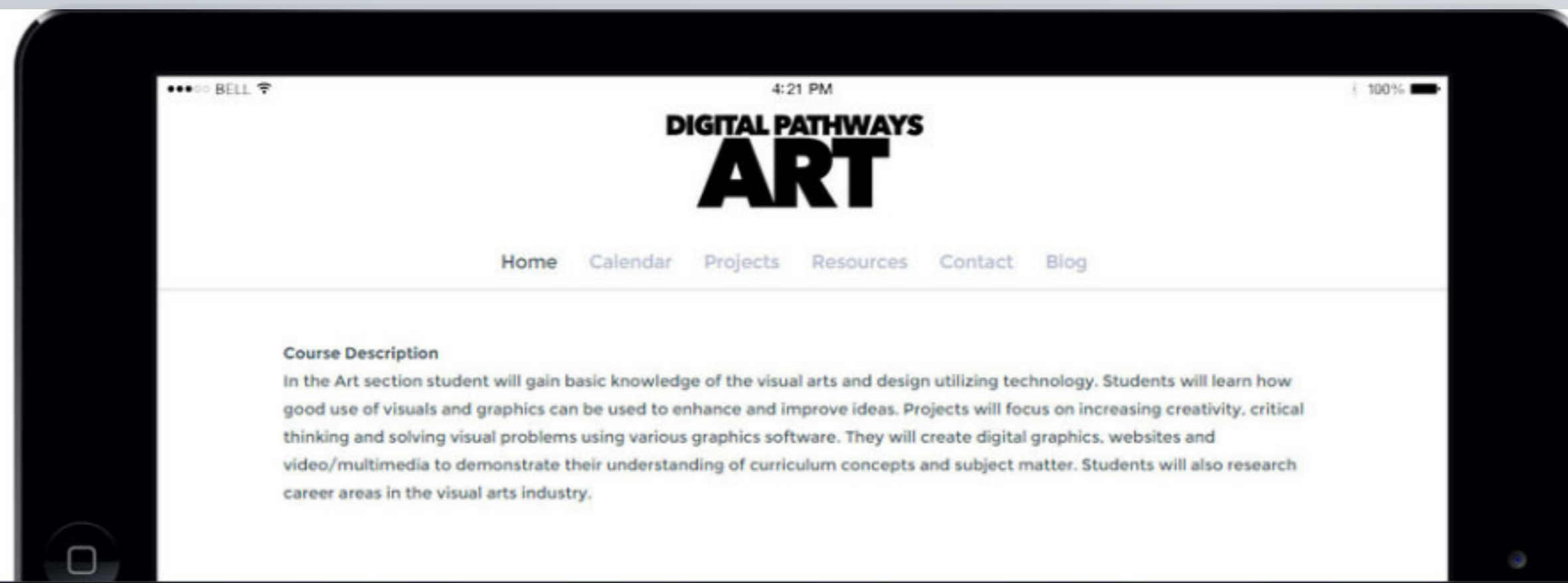

What colors, pictures, fonts to display, and where they are placed on the page.

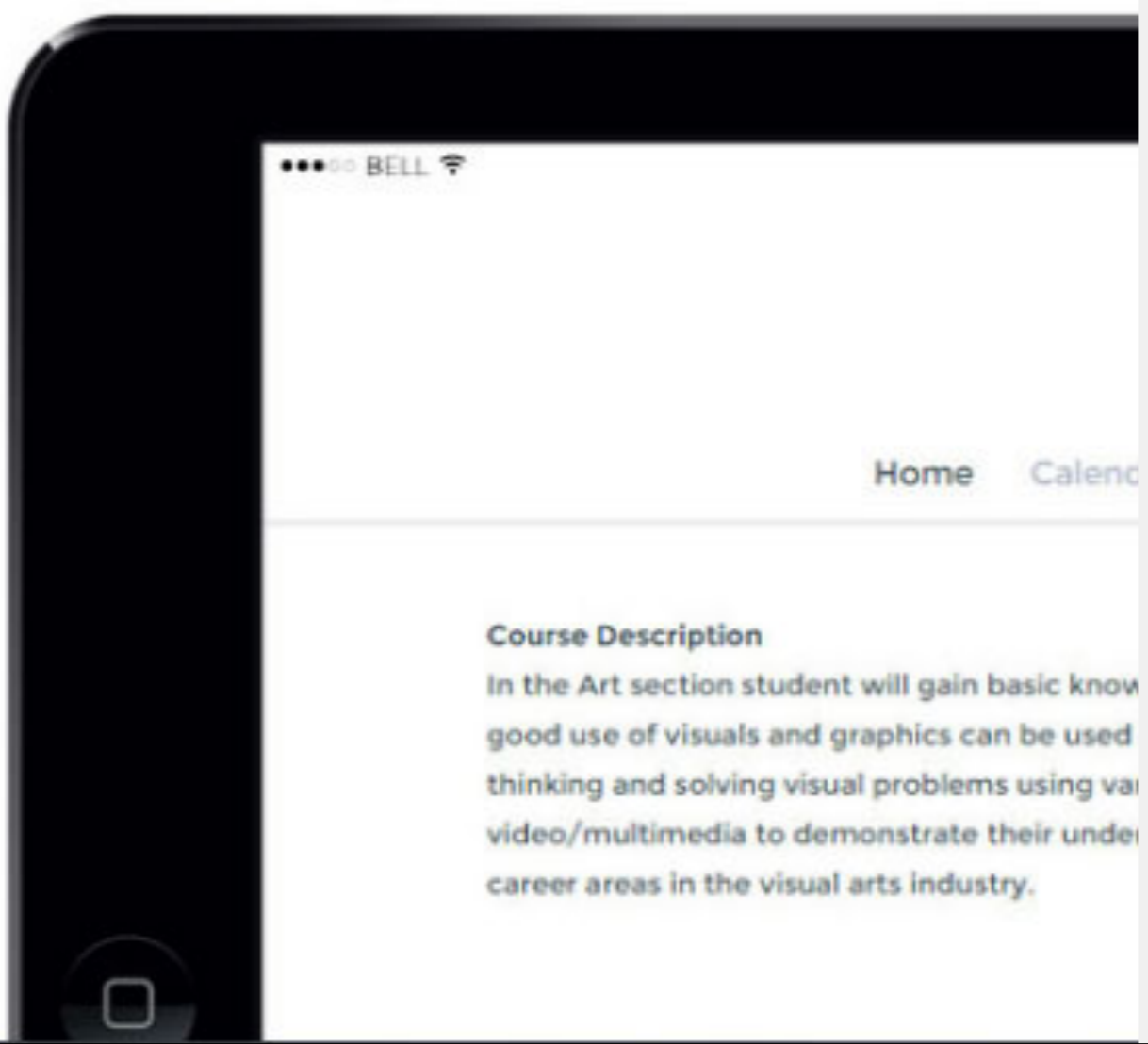
Google has indexed over **one trillion** live web pages to date.

Other computer languages used on the the web are; XHTML, DHTML, Javascript, & CSS.

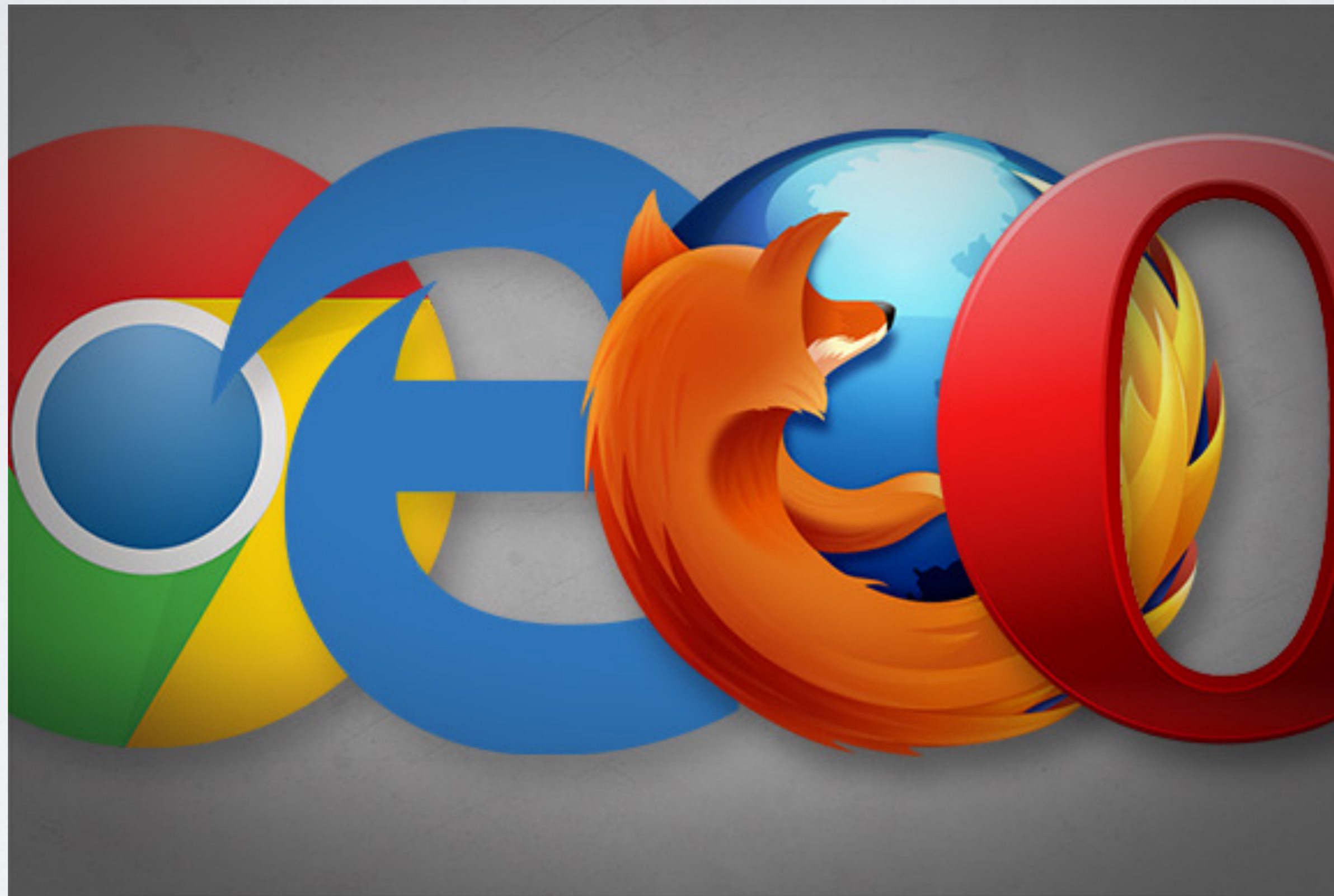
All of these languages extend the basic functions of HTML.

Without it you would only be able to see the computer code that makes up a page.

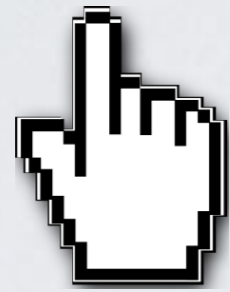
WEB BROWSERS
